

The beginning: Rail line connecting Nuremberg and Fürth with the steam locomotive "Adler"

1933

First high-speed trains from Hamburg to Berlin

1991

New Intercity Express (ICE) trains form the first high-speed rail network in Germany

2002-2010

Various acquisitions, including Arriva, BAX Global, NS Cargo, DSB Gods, Spain-TIR, Romtrans

1920

German Imperial Railway (Deutsche Reichsbahn) established

1949

Split into Deutsche Bundesbahn and Deutsche Reichsbahn

1994

Rail reform: Deutsche Bahn AG established

Merger of Deutscher Bundesbahn and Deutscher Reichsbahn



Deutsche Bahn International Operations founded




